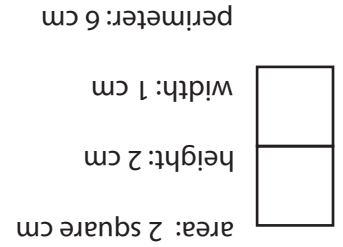
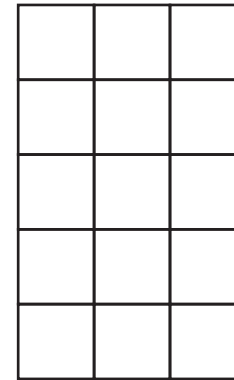
Quadrilaterals are four sided shapes.
Here are some examples:
Rectangle: four right angles
Square: four right angles and four sides the same length
Rhombus: four sides the same length
Parallelogram: two pairs of parallel sides
Trapezoid: one pair of parallel sides

Quadrilaterals



grid: pattern of evenly spaced horizontal and vertical lines
cell: a single square inside a grid
Pattern: a series or a sequence that repeats
row: a horizontal line of cells
column: a vertical line of cells

Rectangle



Area: the space taken up by a shape, measured in square units.
Perimeter: distance around the shape.
Height: vertical measurement
Width: horizontal measurement

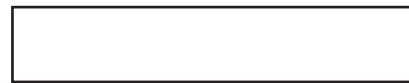
