

Have a class discussion on the value of learning classical roots.

Give each student a copy of the blank handout and have them write words from the Latin root 'ratio' around the sunrise.

Let students work in pairs or small groups to study an example word and explain how its meaning relates to porportionality. Have your class create a long list of synonyms for 'rational' Get them started with: reasonable, balanced, and logical.

If your students are learning another language with classical roots, you might encourage them to search for words related to ratio in those other languages.
