Educational Gift for Winter Vacation

Would you like your students to keep learning over winter vacation?

Send them home with this fun, memory game. Playing games engages working memory. Children have to remember the rules of the game, when their turn comes around, and the location of cards that might match. Tracking all this information gives their working memory a workout. A strong working memory makes learning easier.

Preparation: Give yourself a week or more to assemble decks of memory cards for your students. Decide how to package them for the trip home.

- · Use the page of blank cards to complete the deck as you wish. You could: write each student's name on a card. Write math vocabulary words and a symbol or definition card to match with it.
- · Practice printing cards front and back to make sure the copier is set up correctly. Use thick paper to conceal the designs from the back. Print pages 'actual size' for best results.
- · Print the cards. Make sure there are two matching cards in each student deck.
- · Print instruction pages back to back. Cut out and fold in half. Complete the gift tag on the front.
- Either use the paper cutter to create same sized memory cards for your students, or send home
 the pages with instructions for them to cut them apart at home. Alternatively, let the students cut
 out the cards at school while they listen to a story or watch an educational video.
- · Keep the cards in colorful baggies, an origami card holder, or a couple of rubber bands covered with ribbons. Include the personalized gift tag and instructions.
- Send them home with each student before winter break begins. That way everyone has something
 to keep them busy even if they miss a couple days before winter break.

Please note: Do not change size or scale when copying. Print a single copy first to make sure everything is set up correctly.


For Each Student:

Make a set of Memory Cards:

Copy pages 5 and 7 back to back twice. Copy pages 6 and 7 back to back twice.


If you use both pages 5 and 6 there will be 24 cards with unique designs. Each card needs a match, so there should be 48 cards in total.


Copy pages 9 and 10 back to back. There are six instruction booklets on one page. Cut them out and fold in half. Include one booklet with each deck of Memory Cards.












































































