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


Weaving Multiplication Facts


Instructions



1. Cut out the shapes. Carefully cut along the dotted lines to make strips that you can weave together.



2. Weave the paper together one strip at a time. Use an 'under / over' pattern to create a checkerboard effect. Gently glue the end of each strip to the paper below.




3. Write the labels and numbers on each side. Ensure the number on the bottom right corner is the product of the factors. Use your weaving to help you recall multiplication math facts.


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
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


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
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
